


George Washington

George Washington was born on February 22, 1732 in Westmoreland County in the Colony of Virginia. He was homeschooled. A popular story about Washington involves him as a young boy having chopped down his father cherry tree. When questioned about the tree, he told his father "I can't tell a lie, Pa". He held jobs as a surveyor, a planter and as a soldier. He married Martha Dandridge Custis in 1759. In 1775, Congress appointed George as the commander of the newly formed Continental. Elected in 1789, Washington served as the first president of the United States of America. He served two terms as president from 1789 to 1797. He did not have a political party, but did represent Virginia. On December 14, 1799 George passed away in Mount Vernon, Virginia. George Washington has his face carved on Mount Rushmore and his portrait is also on the quarter and one-dollar bill. He is called the "Father of His Country".
